For the Senior Projects Workshop that will be held on Friday, May 5 you have to prepare a **poster** describing your project. The poster should be a one-slide PowerPoint file with the following content:

- Poster header:
 - Project title. Specify this is a CS426 Senior Project, Spring 2006, or, where appropriate (Teams 1 and 2 only), specify this is a CS426/CPE426 Senior Project, Spring 2006.
 - Team members' names and affiliation ("Department of Computer Science and Engineering, University of Nevada, Reno" or "CSE Department, UNR")
 - Instructor's name and affiliation
 - External advisor(s)' names and their affiliation

- Poster body:
 - Project abstract (between 80 and 160 words)
 - Project description: concise presentation of the project's main goals, features, and architecture. This part should be structured in several sections of your choice. You can use text and diagrams from your project's specification and design parts and I strongly recommend inclusion of at least one snapshot of your program's user interface.
 - Future work: at least three directions of further development
 - Conclusions (between 80 and 160 words)
 - [Optional] Acknowledgments
 - [Optional] Main references

- Poster footer:
 - Coursework notice: "This project was developed in 2005/2006 as part of the course CS426/CPE426 Senior Projects" (include CPE426 only when appropriate)

In addition to the poster itself submit also the completed **checklists** used in your internal review for this phase of the project (see attached file "SP2006_POST_checks.xls").

By the due date submit your poster to the instructor who, with help from the CSE Department, will take care of printing the project posters. For your reference, samples of previous Senior Project posters (2003, 2004, and 2005) are available on the course website.
