

## **Call for Special Session and Tutorial Proposals**

The Twenty Fourth International Conference on Software Engineering and Data Engineering (SEDE 2015) will take place October 12-14, 2015 in San Diego, California. The SEDE 2015 organizing committee invites proposals for special sessions and tutorials.

### **Special Session Requirements**

Special sessions supplement to the regular program for SEDE 2015. Each special session should highlight important research topics in a field of interest related to software engineering and/or data engineering.

Each special session should have 4-5 papers. The following information should be included in the proposal:

- Title of the proposed special session.
- Names/affiliation of the organizer (including brief bio and contact info).
- List of invited papers (including a tentative title and author list).

### **Tutorial Requirements**

The following information should be included in the proposal:

- Title of the proposed tutorial.
- A short description of the material to covered.
- Contact information and a brief bio of the presenter.
- Expected audiences.

### **Proposal Submission Guidelines**

Proposals will be evaluated based on the timeliness of the topic and relevance to SEDE, as well as the qualifications of the organizers, quality of papers in the proposed special session or content of the tutorial.
